- 7. All notices required hereunder will be addressed to the parties at the addresses printed below their names, until other notice of change of address is given in writing and will be by certified mail, return receipt requested. Notices so given will be effective on the date of receipt thereof.
- 8. This shall constitute the entire Agreement between the parties. No changes, modifications, or alterations thereof will be effective unless contained in a writing signed by both parties.
- 9. This Agreement, and all written modifications, alterations, supplements, and amendments hereto contained in writing signed by the parties will be binding on the parties, their executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors, and assigns.

10. This Agreement is intended to be gender neutral. Terms appearing herein which
traditionally refer to a particular gender are used for convenience only and shall be
understood and interpreted to refer to the genders of the respective parties hereto.
Optional 11. In addition to the salary provided in Paragraph 5 above, the Producer shall
provide the Musician with transportation from Musician's city of origin to the city in
